



Biosecurity Compliance Declaration

Synplogen Co., Ltd., a nucleic acid synthesis service provider, hereby certifies that it complies with the U.S. Nucleic Acid Synthesis Screening Framework issued by the Office of Science and Technology Policy (OSTP) and applicable to nucleic acid synthesis service providers supporting federally funded customers, and that it adheres to the following provisions.

- Screen purchase orders for synthetic nucleic acids to identify any sequences of concern (SOCs).
- Screen customers who submit purchase orders of synthetic nucleic acids with SOCs to verify legitimacy.
- Report potentially illegitimate purchase orders of synthetic nucleic acids involving SOCs to the relevant authorities.
- Retain records relating to purchase orders for synthetic nucleic acids.
- Take steps to ensure cybersecurity and information security.


Our company is a member of the industry-led independent organization, the International Gene Synthesis Consortium (IGSC), which aims to develop and implement standardized screening protocols for DNA synthesis orders. We conduct DNA synthesis in accordance with the "Harmonized Screening Protocol," the screening guidelines established by the IGSC. This guideline is designed to provide supplemental rules and guidance for screening ordered sequences and the customers who order them, with the goal of enhancing safety and biosecurity.

We strive to meet the requirements of the OSTP Framework and agree to promptly update this statement should any change occur in our compliance status.
